### Instructions to use the equipment safely:

#### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

**WARNING:** The brush cutter, if properly used, is a quick, comfortable and efficient tool. So that your work is always pleasant and safe, please respect the following safety precautions scrupulously.

- 1 - Never use the brush cutter when you are tired or fatigued.
- 2 - Wear appropriate clothing and safety articles such as: boots, heavy-duty trousers, gloves, protective eyewear, ear protection and protective helmet. Use clothing which is close-fitting but comfortable.
- 3 - Do not allow children to use the brush cutter.
- 4 - Do not allow other people to remain within 15 metres during brush cutter use.
- 5 - Before using the brush cutter, make sure that the blade fixing bolt is well-tightened.
- 6 - The brush cutter must be equipped with the cutting accessories recommended by the manufacturer.
- 7 - Never use the brush cutter without the blade guard or the head.
- 8 - Before starting the engine, make sure that the throttle lever works freely.
- 9 - Every now and then while working, stop the engine and check the blade. Replace it at the first sign of cracks or breaks.
- 10 - Before starting the engine, make sure that the blade is free to move and is not in contact with any foreign objects.
- 11 - With the engine idling, the blade should not turn. If it does, regulate the idle adjustment screw.
- 12 - Carry the brush cutter with the engine off and with the protective blade cover on.
- 13 - Only work when you are in a stable and secure position.
- 14 - Start the brush cutter only in well-ventilated areas.
- 15 - Never touch the blade or attempt any maintenance work while the engine is running.
- 16 - Fill the fuel tank with the engine off and away from heat sources. Do not smoke while filling the tank.
- 17 - Do not remove the fuel tank cap when the engine is running.
- 18 - Be careful not to spill fuel on the ground or on the engine.
- 19 - If fuel spills out during filling, move the brush cutter away before starting the engine.
- 20 - Do not use fuel mixture for cleaning operations.
- 21 - Do not check the spark plug spark near the cylinder port.
- 22 - Never work with a damaged muffler.
- 23 - Always keep the handles clean of oil and fuel.
- 24 - Store the brush cutter in a dry place, away from heat sources, and off the ground.
- 25 - Do not start the engine with the arm not mounted.
- 26 - In order to avoid hitting stones or other objects, do not cut too close to the ground.
- 27 - Check the brush cutter daily to be sure that components and safety devices are full functioning properly.
- 28 - Do not attempt to carry out operations or repairs that are not part of the normal maintenance. See the authorised dealer.
